#### Scope of Work – Content Development

- Support the ongoing development and refinement of various elementary, middle school, and high school curriculum
- Work with subject matter experts to develop lesson packages (may include PPT files, teacher notes, assessment items, and others)
- Work with subject matter experts to incorporate teacher feedback (as provided)
- Create, update, or supplement module content as identified with subject matter experts
- Keep an updated draft for team review in a common shared folder (e.g. Google Drive or SharePoint)
- Notify via email when updated files are uploaded to the shared folder

#### Desired Qualifications

- Familiarity with national standard models, including NGSS, ELA and Math CCSS, and CSTA
- Familiarity with Anchor and investigative Phenomena as they relate to NGSS
- Experience in writing project-based or problem-based curricula, lessons, or activities
- Experience in programming is a plus, but not a requirement

This opportunity is for contractor-status on a work-for-hire basis. Contractors are not full-time employees of CYBER.ORG nor is this an hourly-based opportunity. Instead, compensation is based on materials developed and submitted. All work created as a result of the work being performed under contract for CYBER.ORG becomes property of the Cyber Innovation Center.
