



Professional Development Contractor *Rolling opportunity beginning Summer 2021*

Through a grant from the US Department of Homeland Security’s Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), CYBER.ORG hosts professional development workshops for K12 teachers to give them the skills and confidence to integrate cybersecurity into their classrooms. During the summer of 2021, CYBER.ORG will participate in cybersecurity-focused conferences, customizable workshops for schools and districts, and week-long intensive “boot camps” for high school teachers. These virtual workshops and presentations will feature CYBER.ORG’s Cybersecurity curriculum and the US Cyber Range.

We are seeking a knowledgeable, energetic instructor to support CYBER.ORG’s curriculum development specialists in facilitating virtual hands-on workshops for high school cybersecurity teachers. We aim to create high-quality professional development experiences that are led by a diverse team of approachable, encouraging content specialists.

Scope of Work – Support Delivery of Professional Development Workshops

- Support CYBER.ORG lead instructors in delivery of virtual cybersecurity professional development workshops
- Assist workshop attendees virtually through chat and/or one-on-one instruction in breakout rooms
- Support in the development and preparation for workshops
- Provide post-workshop support to attendees through email communication as needed

Desired Qualifications

- Experience teaching high school cybersecurity
- Proficiency with Linux
- Familiarity with Security+ certification requirements and content knowledge
- Experience in K-12 professional development instruction
- Comfort with virtual instruction in both asynchronous and synchronous formats

This is a remote opportunity. Applicants may be based anywhere in the United States and must be US citizens. This opportunity is for contractor-status on a work-for-hire basis. Contractors are not full-time employees of CYBER.ORG nor is this an hourly-based opportunity. Instead, compensation will be set on a per-workshop basis. All work created as a result of the work being performed under contract for CYBER.ORG becomes property of the Cyber Innovation Center.
