CYBER.ORG is currently recruiting qualified Camp Instructors for Project Access. Project Access is a focused initiative of CYBER.ORG to bring cyber education opportunities to students with disabilities, primarily those who are blind or vision impaired.

CYBER.ORG is dedicated to making cybersecurity education available to all K-12 students throughout the US. We believe the next generation of cybersecurity professionals should be representative of the country in which they work to keep secure. To that end, we seek to build a CYBER.ORG team that represents diverse viewpoints and experiences, and we are committed to creating an inclusive environment for all employees.

Job Overview

CYBER.ORG is hiring multiple contractors who will provide classroom instruction to students with disabilities, primarily those who are blind or vision impaired, in a summer camp setting. Camp themes include “Robotics with the Boe-Bot” and “Leap into Linux” (Linux and Web Development).

Contractors will complete 8 hours of virtual training in May 2022 and support at least two (2) week-long, in-person camps during June, July, and/or August, 2022.

Responsibilities

Contractors will support and/or lead instruction for at least two (2) week-long camps for approximately 20 students with disabilities, primarily those who are blind or vision impaired. Curriculum materials, supplies, and training will be provided by CYBER.ORG.

For a week-long camp, contractors should expect to arrive at the camp venue on Sunday, teach M-F from approximately 9 am to 4 pm, and depart on either Friday evening or Saturday morning after the camp ends. There may be some instructional team meetings in the evenings after the day’s instruction has concluded.

Qualifications

Required

- Able to spend at minimum two full weeks (may or may not be consecutive) traveling
- For Leap Into Linux: Experience with Linux command line and “hand-coding” HTML (no GUI)
- For Robotics with the Boe-Bot: Experience with text-based programming and robotics
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills

Preferred

- Classroom teaching experience with teaching certification
- Experience teaching students with disabilities, especially blind and visually impaired students

Compensation

\$800/week with reimbursement for travel, food, and lodging
